John was 23 years old when he died and had just finished college. He has two younger sisters: Olivia and Gracie. They are 18 and 16 years old. I have included a photo of the three of them; I took it at our last Christmas together.

John loved his family and friends. He would do anything for anyone, especially his two sisters! John also loved woodworking and football. He built me a nightstand not long before he passed, and I will treasure it forever. He was a huge Colts fan and always scheduled his weekends around games. Growing up, he often had his many friends over to our house to watch the games. I was tasked with ordering pizzas and cleaning up after them, but I cherish those memories of youthful boyhood energy filling my home.

Though devastated by the tragedy of John's death, we were overcome with pride that John had registered as an organ and tissue donor. It made so much sense considering he would give the shirt off his back to anyone who needed it. We miss John so very much but are comforted by the fact that he lives on through you and others.
